




Conversation with Amy Baron Secretary to Building Inspector June 8, 2007

## RE: 243 Groton Road or 1 Ward Way

Upon requesting the information about the above mentioned building, Amy was able to give me a brief history of the building. Amy worked for the Marinel Bus Company in the 1970's. Amy explianed George Marinel owned the property and built the current bus garage on the site in 1971. Amy produced a plot plan on file with the Building Inspector's Office to validate the date. It is apparent that 1 Ward Way was not on the plan. On the location of 1 Ward Way, there was a septic system tht Amy recalls having to have pumped at regular intervals. One Ward Way was built as a guard shack in the middle to late 1970's. There is no record of the shack being built on file with the Building Inspector's Office.
