9. Historical significance (include explanation of themes checked above)

This house was built for George H. Holt, who manufactured pumps on the premises, probably in a shop erected to the rear of the house in 1877 (unattach) Construction of the house began in 1868 and was completed 6 years later. Between 1911 and 1955 it was owned by the Reis family, having been purchased from the Holt's. Andrew Reis was a stone cutter, probably for the nearby granite quarries in West Chelmsford/Westford. His widow Hulda died about 1943, and ownership passed to one of their sons, Oscar E. Reis. In 1955, 3 years after his death, Oscar's widow, Helen, sold it out of the family, ending 44 years of Reis ownership (Holt ownership covered 43 years.). In 1965-67 the original 10 acre lot was subdivided by a developer.

The barn & shop built to the right and rear of the house 1876-77 apparently was replaced by a new barn & henhouse in 1939. This was torn down ca 1965-66 probably by Robert Hicks, a real estate developer, who owned the property for  $1\frac{1}{2}$  years. The foundation can still be seen.




